- 3) If you bring items that fall outside of these guidelines, they will be discarded.

You will learn how to set up an inventory, as well as answer questions.

Atriuum's Online Public Access (OPAC) (In-person & Zoom)

This session will cover OPAC. OPAC is what your patrons use to access your database. We will cover how to customize OPAC for your library, as well as answer questions.

Book Repair (In-person)

Learn how to make old books new again, showing you how to make repairs to damaged items.

Creating Bookmarks For Your Library Patrons (In-person)

Come to this hands-on workshop to create bookmarks from old greeting cards. Bring a good pair of scissors or cutting board along with unwanted greeting cards to repurpose -- the more, the better, since some cards are more suitable for this purpose than others. Optional: bring examples of other types of bookmarks you have made for a display.

Freeware for the Display, Capture, Conversion and Archiving of Digital Media (In-person) Ron Buckles

This class will be a presentation of free, well-known and proven safe software tools that aids in the capturing, editing and archiving of video, image and audio files. Also included is an introduction in how and why information is converted to digital.
